

How to Self-Attest and Access SafeSport Status

All 18+ SCRC members are Relevant Adult Participants due to the SCRC's masters and youth program overlap with club events and practices at the site. Read the 2023 USRowing SafeSport Self-Attestation for Relevant Adult Participants and how to log into your membership account [here](#).

Complaint status, no action required

1. "Self Attested, SafeSport Training Required" and a current safesport course completed

No action is required and member is permitted to row. To the right is an example of the only compliant status at SCRC:

Non-compliant statuses, action required before member is permitted to row any boat (club or private)

1. "Self Attested, Not Required" **SafeSport**

- Solution: **Self Attested, Not Required**
- Click the blue "SafeSport" text and scroll down to "Re-take Self Attestation"
- Select answers for first and second questions as applicable in the SafeSport Requirement Self Attestation
- All 18+ members must select "YES" for the third question regarding regular contact with any minor athletes, hit submit, and complete assigned safesport course (may be 90 minute or 30 minute refresher)
